The "MS" load line shall be assigned only to those particular vessels that qualify under the Regulations. The "SW" marks need only be assigned to Great Lakes vessels loading in salt water of the St. Lawrence River west of a straight line from Cap des Rosiers to West Point Anticosti Island, and west of a line along longitude 63 degrees west from Anticosti Island to the north shore of the St. It is the owner's responsibility to furnish the master with approved information and instructions for loading and ballasting this vessel to provide Lawrence River. guidance as to stability of the vessel under varying conditions of service and to avoid unacceptable stresses in the vessel's structure, as defined in 46 CFR 45.105.
