(Polymerizes and highly toxic) Must comply with requirements of Categories 1, 2 and 3,

Category 5

(High vapor pressure) VCS pressure drop calculations for cargoes with a vapor pressure greater than 14.7 psia at 115 F must take into account increased vapor-air mixture densities and vapor growth rates as compared to Category 1 cargoes. Consult the Marine Safety Center's VCS Guidelines for further information. This requirement is in addition to the requirements of Category 1.

Category 6

(High vapor pressure and highly toxic) Must comply with requirements of Categories 1, 3 and 5. (High vapor pressure and polymerizes) Must comply with requirements of Categories 1, 2 and 5,

Category 7

The cargo has not been evaluated/classified for use in vapor control systems
