Per 46 CFR 39, excluding Part 39.4000, this vessel's vapor control system (VCS) has been inspected to the plans approved by Marine Safety Center letter serial #C1-1000198 dated 28-JAN-2010, an extension of Marine Safety Center letter Serial #C1-0801180 dated 16-APR-2008, and found acceptable for collection of bulk liquid cargo vapors annotated with "Yes" in the CAA's VCS column.

\*Stability and Trim\*

Per 46 CFR 151.10(c) (2), the maximum tank weights listed above reflect uniform (within 5%) loading at the deepest draft allowed. When carrying Subchapter "O" cargoes at shallower drafts, the barge should always be loaded uniformly.

The maximum design density of cargo which may be filled to the tank top is 8.745 lbs/gal. Cargoes with higher densities, up to 12.8 lbs/gal, may be carried as slack loads, but shall not exceed the tank weight limits as listed above.


