With our letter to you of December 23, 2003, Kirby Inland Marine, LP ("Kirby") advised that all vessels owned and/or operated by Kirby which are subject to the requirements of 33 CFR Part 104 will operate under the American Waterways Operators Alternative Security Program for Tugboats, Towboats and Barges dated October 31, 2007, and approved in 33 CFR 101.125(b), which Program will be implemented in its entirety.
